Adam Braun is the Founder and CEO of Pencils for Promise, an award-winning nonprofit that has opened more than 150 schools across Africa, Asia and Latin America. In 2012, he was named to the Forbes 30 Under 30 list. Inspired by a begging boy who asked for a pencil on the streets of India, Braun left a dream job to launch his nonprofit, which was awarded “Education Organization of the Year” in 2013. A triple major graduate from Brown University, Braun has been featured at Clinton Global Initiative, Google Zeitgeist and in *Wired Magazine’s* 2012 Smart List of 50 People Changing the World. He has a massive online following, and will debut his book, *The Promise of a Pencil: How an Ordinary Person Can Create Extraordinary Change*, in March.
