

**APPENDIX K - ATTACHMENT 1**  
**Possible OSU Alert Circumstances**

- A. Examples of significant emergencies or dangerous situations (not exhaustive):
- Outbreak of serious illness (Coronavirus, meningitis, Norovirus, etc.).
  - Extreme weather conditions (tornado, hurricane, etc.).
  - Earthquake.
  - Gas leak.
  - Bomb threat/Terrorist incident.
  - Armed intruder.
  - Civil unrest or rioting.
  - Building fire/Explosion.
  - Nearby chemical or hazardous waste spill.
- B. Clery Act-defined Crimes:
1. Primary crimes, including –
    - a. Criminal homicide:
      - 1) Murder and non-negligent manslaughter.
      - 2) Negligent manslaughter.
    - b. Sex offenses:
      - 1) Rape.
      - 2) Fondling.
      - 3) Incest.
      - 4) Statutory rape.
    - c. Robbery.
    - d. Aggravated assault.
    - e. Burglary.
    - f. Motor vehicle theft.
    - g. Arson.
  2. Arrests and referrals for disciplinary actions, including –
    - a. Arrests for liquor law violations, drug law violations and illegal weapons possession.
    - b. Persons not arrested, but who were referred for campus disciplinary action for liquor law violations, drug law violations and illegal weapons possession.
  3. Hate crimes, including –
    - a. The number of each type of crime in section (B)(1) that are determined to be hate crimes.
    - b. The number of the following crimes that are determined to be hate crimes:
      - 1) Larceny-theft.
      - 2) Simple assault.
      - 3) Intimidation.
      - 4) Destruction/damage/vandalism of property.
  4. Dating violence, domestic violence, and stalking.

- C. Activity or behavior that, while not necessarily criminal nor falling into Clery Act defined categories, presents a substantial risk to campus security.
